The recommended actuarial program is completed in years 1 to 4, together with the 100-, 200- and 300-level LAW units which commence in year 2. The LLB is completed in years 5 and 6.

There is considerable variety in the range of law units which may be studied in the final two years of the program. Students should discuss their options for these years with an academic adviser from the Division of Law.

Before enrolling each year students should consult the Macquarie University Handbook and check the compulsory LAW units.

ACST400 and ACST401 may be deferred to a later year.
